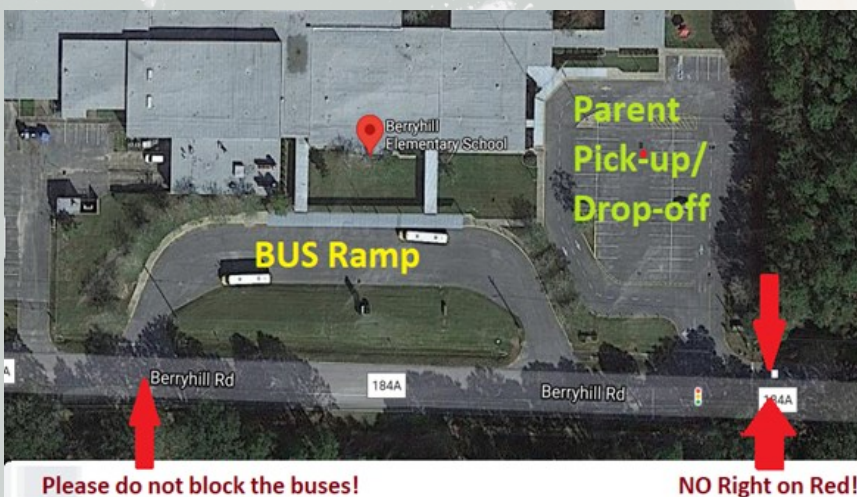
Safety Reminders!

No Right on Red – In the westbound turn lane going into the school, please be aware of the this posted sign (unless directed by the deputy otherwise).

Parent Pick-up – Keep the righthand lane open until 1:15 to 1:20 p.m. This ensures other parents, deliveries and emergency vehicles can access the front office.

The SCHOOL ZONE SPEED LIMIT is 20 MPH. Please be mindful of your speed.

Do not BLOCK buses. For those in parent pick-up using the eastbound turn lane, please do not block the exit route for the buses! Leave them a wide space to get out because they need to leave.
