School Responsibilities

Berryhill Elementary School will:

- 1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards.** Berryhill will strive to provide each child the necessary curriculum and instruction to meet his or her needs to be successful.
- 2. Hold parent-teacher conferences (at least annually in elementary schools) during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement.** Orientation sessions will be offered at the beginning of the school term for parents to become familiar with school policies and procedures. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress.** Students in grades 1-5 will receive a report card, and students in grades K will receive a progress report aligned to the new Florida Standards every nine weeks. Mid-Term Progress Reports will be provided at the midpoint of each grading period.
- 4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff.** Teachers and staff are available to parents under mutually agreed upon arrangements.

5. **Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities.** Parents are afforded the opportunity to become a part of the school volunteer program by filling out a volunteer application. Parent participation is generally up to the discretion of the classroom teacher

Parent Responsibilities
