3. Budget Items

Mrs. Chapman discussed the following budget items listed below.

- School Improvement Balance (SI Funds) \$0
- <u>Supplemental Academic Instruction Balance (SAI Funds)</u> \$203.48
 These funds may only be spent on materials/activities outside of the regular school academic day such as tutoring, Saturday School or Summer School/summer learning

(Tara Moore motioned to approve the budget balances. Rebecca Sterzing seconds the motion.)

• School Based Budget **reduction** from the District in the amount of \$7,051 on 11/09/2020 and \$7,417.32 on 1/19/2021 for a total reduction of **\$14,468.32**.

• On 5/18/2021, we received notice that we will not receive funding for the next school year until after the October FTE. These funds are usually allocated to the school at the first of July. With the reduction and now the delay in additional funding, we had to freeze copying and spending from teacher accounts.

4. Berryhill Elementary School-Parent Compact

Mrs. Chapman provided a copy of the 2020-2021 Berryhill School Compact. She explained that the 21-22 compact would be similar. She asked all members to read and offer any suggestions for changes. She said that the school year would be changed to 2021-2022 and the principal and assistant principal information would be corrected. Melissa Caudell mentioned adding that parents monitor children's screen time to the section that listed parent responsibilities. Tara Moore mentioned adding call out to the same section referring to parents receiving call outs and responding. No other corrections were mentioned or discussed. Stephanie Barnes motions to approve the 21-22 Compact with the corrections and changes implemented. Misty Lemke seconds the motion.
